As the approaching fall is creeping up on us, we need to be aware of the increase in traffic in the community as the snow birds are returning. Walkers and drivers should both be aware of the traffic.

Also, there will be an increase in the golf cart traffic. This is also a reminder to every one of the Florida laws for golf carts as well the rules per the High Point bilaws:

- Golf Carts are only to be driven between the hours of SUNRISE and SUNSET No Exceptions.
- •All golf carts are to be registered with and assigned number through the office or the Golf Club.
- •The bi-laws require that golf carts be insured with proof of insurance and then given a sticker to be applied to the front windshield.
- Beginning October 1st 2023 a person operating a golf cart on public roads or streets who is under the age of 18 MUST possess a valid learners driver's license or valid driver's license and a person who is 18 years of age or older must possess a valid form government issued photographic identification. Please google "golf cart laws in Florida in 2024" for further clarification.

A reminder that a recommended speed limit on High Point Blvd between Little Ave. and Diplomacy has been posted to be 20 mph. This was posted due to the curves in that area are close and those backing out onto the boulevard were having problems of clear visibility of the oncoming traffic in that area.

We resumed our monthly meeting on September 23rd at 7pm in the community center. We always meet on the 4th Monday of the month, September to April. Everyone is welcome as we always have our Hernando County Sheriff representative there to update us on activity in our area and answer any questions.

Garden Club Article for December 2024 Landscaping Tips By Tom Anderson, Univ. of Florida Master Gardener



"Soil Testing, Cold Weather Protection, Invasive Vines, Hernando County Fertilizer Ordinance, Fall Classes and High Point Garden Club Christmas Dinner" "Happy Holidays!"

Soil Testing – According to the University of Florida Extension Service December is a good time to do a Soil Test if some of your plants did not perform as desired this past year. A Soil Test will not tell you why a plant died, it will only show the make-up of your soil and will help you determine how much and what kind of nutrients or elements you may need to add to attain the soil you desire.

Cold Weather Protection - It is time to start preparing for "Cold Spells." A well-watered soil 24 hours prior to a frost/cold spell will allow the soil to absorb solar radiation and reradiate heat during the night of the freeze. Never Attempt to Irrigate/water during the Freeze! Plant/shrub blankets must extend down to the ground and not be in contact with the foliage. Cloth covers are preferable to plastic, but any covering will help. Invasive Climbing Vines/Briars Control - In May we talked about our most prevalent Invasive Vines and Briars including Skunk Vine, Virginia Creeper, Smilax/Greenbrier and Air Potato Vine. The only sure way to eliminate these vines is to pull or dig them out by the roots/bulbs. However, there is an effective selective systemic herbicide called "Triclopyr" (triclo-per) that is used to control woody broadleaf vines, briars, and other plants. If you choose to use an herbicide containing "Triclopyr" it will kill other woody plants including shrubs. Crossbow and Crossroads are two of the brands that contain Triclopyr. Follow label

Don't forget that the Hernando County Fertilizer Ordinance prohibits application of any turf fertilizers containing Nitrogen (N) and/or Phosphorus (P) as follows:

- 1. Fertilizers containing Nitrogen are prohibited from June 1st through Sept. 30th and December 15th through March 15th.
- 2. Commercial Providers are no longer exempt from the prohibitions.
- 3. Fertilizers cannot be applied within 25 feet of wetlands and surface waters.

Commercial businesses that sell fertilizers are required to post county-provided signage stating the restrictions during the prohibited time frames.

Summer time turf enrichments including Iron (Fe) for greening or Potassium (K), Magnesium (Mg) and compost products are encouraged.
